Tournament Time Again!
If you haven't entered before, now's the time. With your membership renewal form you will have received a tournament entry form for 2011.

Club Championship – Singles, Doubles, and Mixed doubles

Straight knockout competition, entries close 6th May. Finals on Sunday 11th September

There is a plate competition for the first round singles losers, Silverware for the winners and commemorative engraved glasses for finalists.

Handicap Tournament – Singles Doubles and Mixed Doubles

Knockout competition with a twist – weaker players get a head start in each game and the stronger players have to start on minus points. It means that anyone can win. Entries close 5th August, and the finals day is Sunday 25th September. Commemorative engraved glasses for the finalists.

Family Cup

Knockout doubles competition for family members. Also handicapped.

Entries close 20th May, and finals day is Sunday 25th September

Silverware for the winners and commemorative engraved glasses for finalists.

AMB Trophy Tournament

This trophy was kindly donated to the club to mark the opening of the new courts by the company that installed them. This is a one day adult mixed doubles tournament taking place on Sunday 15th May.

Last year was the first time we ran this and we called it a “Pro-Am” event with team players representing the “Pros” and social players the “Amateurs”. Successful entrants will be paired with a partner by the tournament committee and then on the day there will be a round robin event where the pairing with the highest number of games won in the afternoon will be the winners. A simple and fun format with a challenge for everyone.
