Men's Team Practices

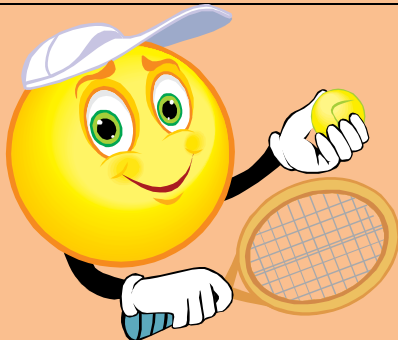
Men's team practices continue on Sunday evenings at 6.00 pm and will continue until Easter.

The “Other” Prestbury Tennis Club

There have been a number of issues recently in getting members “linked” to our club through the LTA. It is important for members who have a BTM (British Tennis Membership) number to “associate” with the club:

- It means free BTM for the member
- It affects the number of tickets we get allocated for the Wimbledon draw
- Players wanting to increase ratings through recording matches played within Cheshire need to be linked to a club within Cheshire.

The Club Secretary cannot link an individual member to the club. This has to be done, either by the individual member (by logging onto the website) or by the secretary contacting the LTA.

So – if you are trying to link your membership to Prestbury – please note the following:

- There are 2 clubs registered with the LTA called Prestbury Tennis Club (the other one is in Gloucestershire)
- **Within the LTA we are officially known as Prestbury Village Lawn Tennis Club.**
- Our LTA reference number is CHE062
