Men's Team Update

Our **First Team** have fielded strong sides in two matches, featuring club coaches Jon Cain and Jarek Dabros and three under 20s (Sean Sivewright, Connor Moran and Lewis Denton), and recorded two comfortable wins, 13-2 at home to Bramhall Park 1 and 17-0 away to Northern 2. Their record now stands at W2 D0 L1.

The only match scheduled for the **Second Team** was rained off (the first of the season for any of the men's teams), so their record remains at W2 D1 L2.

The **Third Team** suffered another heavy defeat, 16-2 at home to Cheadle, but bounced back with a welcome 8-4 win away to Hazel Grove. Their record stands at W2 D0 L4.

The **Fourth Team** lost their fifth match of the season 9-4 at home to Bramhall Park 3 and, disappointingly, the next match was cancelled due to Strines withdrawing from the league – W3 D0 L2.

Our **Fifths** have recorded another win and another loss and they now stand at W4 D0 L3.
