Tennis Rules and Tennis Etiquette

The rules of tennis are how to play the game

The etiquette is how to conduct yourself on court

Getting on court

Do not enter the courts if a point is being played, wait until the end of the point or a break in the game.

Collect stray balls when it is safe to do so and not while someone is playing a point.

Good behaviour on court is expected at all times

There should be no

- Bad language

- Throwing your racquet about

- Hitting balls around the court in anger

- Arguing over line calls

The person who is receiving the shot has the final say over whether the ball was in or out. If the line call is unsure you can always agree to play the point again.

Shake hands with team members and opposition at the end of a match.

Looking After the Courts

Please drag the clay courts after use, unless they are wet with rain.

Please take your drinks bottles and sweet wrappers off the court and put them in the litter bins.

Check you have not left any clothing or equipment on court.

Membership

Always wear your shoe tags to prove your membership. If you bring a visitor, sign them in the visitors book and pay the visitor fee.
