ANTI-BULLYING SUMMARY POLICY

WE RECOGNISE THAT:

- Bullying is defined as a range of abusive behaviour that is repeated and intended to hurt someone either physically or emotionally.
- Bullying causes real distress. It can affect a person's health and development and, at the extreme, can cause significant harm.

WE WILL AS A CLUB:

- Prominently display and make children aware of helpline numbers
- Make new members aware of our policies and codes of conduct
- Remind existing members of our policies and codes of conduct every year
- Contact parents when a child is reported about bullying another child.

MEMBERS MUST:

- Report incidents of bullying behaviour when they see it or hear about it to the Welfare Officer.

- Observe the club code of conduct.

MEMBERS MUST NOT:

- Tolerate bad behaviour or accept excuses for bullying behaviour.

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
